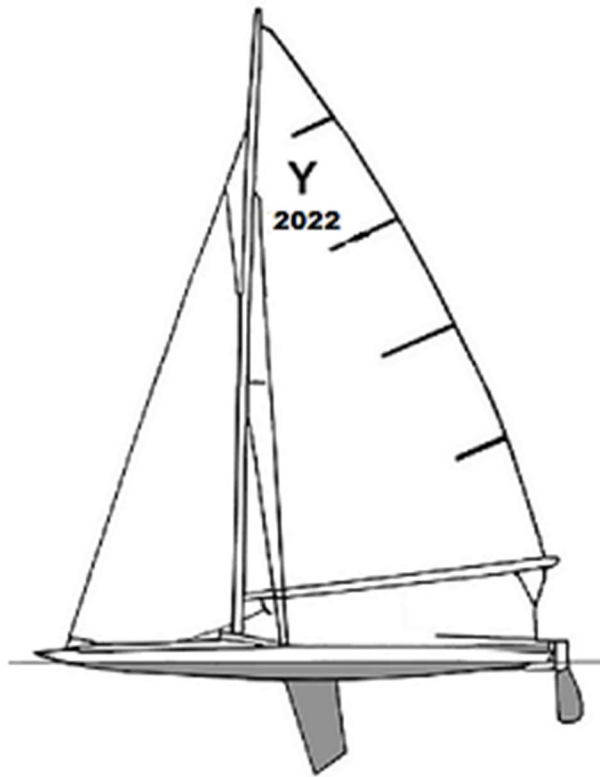

CALLING ALL JUNIORS!!!

If you are not familiar with LNYC junior sailing program, I can assure you that it is a high priority with this club membership. They host HS sailing events year-round and have a robust junior sailing camp every year; a truly first-class operation. We need to make this year's event a "must attend" for all juniors across the spectrum of fleets. A goal set would be to have at least one junior from all 8 of our sailing areas. Last year's winner, Hartley Meyer from area 5 promised to defend and we will hold her to her word LOL. Efforts are underway to allow for some late arrivals on Sunday to make a weigh-in early Monday morning prior to the first starting sequence.
