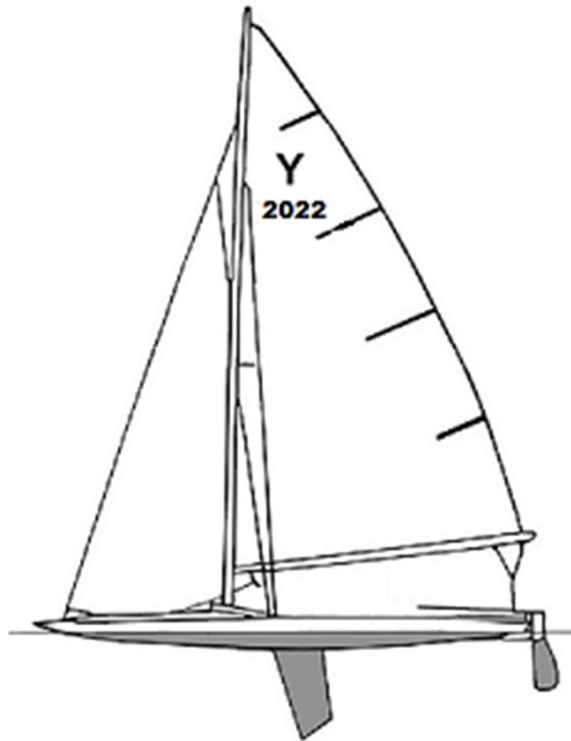

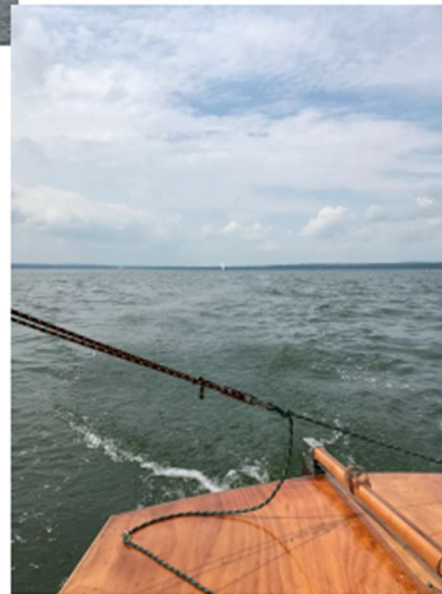

From the President

2022 Nationals have come and gone and happy to report WE GOT ONE IN THE HISTORY BOOKS!! Our sailing has taken an incredible number of hits over the past two and a half years from a pandemic, to lockdowns, borders closed (going and coming), exorbitant gas prices and availability taking us back to the early 70's. The additional side shows from "murder hornets" to Monkey Pox didn't help much but happy to have had the time to share with fellow Y sailors at Lake Norman this past week. I'm beginning to forget what "normal" looks like however, finally getting a National Championship series in the books was a huge relief.

Conditions at lake Norman tested both the sailors and the race committee regarding the predominantly light (sometimes nonexistent) wind conditions however, five races were recorded over the three day event. As per my usual staring at results, pondering the closeness of racing scores and disparity of finishes that seemed to prevail, The word "Wonky" comes to mind. I guess that is what happens when you combine great competition with seemingly unpredictable conditions. Bottom line...the good guys always rise to the top regardless and seem to be unaffected by a race or two that tested patience as well as religion. It confirms my long held opinion that light air sailing is about 90% attitude and 10% patience.

While coaching HS sailing team here a half dozen years ago, I came into a program that had 6 freshman sailors who had started the Waccamaw sailing team and wished to compete in SEISA events. At one particular race in Charleston Harbor with light winds prevailing, I asked the team to listen to the conversations on the dock among other teams. Complaints regarding the present conditions were the rule, NO ONE WANTED TO SAIL!. I pointed out to my young team that those who found the conditions intolerable were already beaten before they left the dock. Further, I posited that the very first race any of these young sailors would win would be in light air conditions simply because they wanted to be out there sailing more so than the others. As the season wore on, and light conditions prevailed, each one of them found their way to the top of the fleet taking first in the light winds available on a given race. Attitude rules and that was quite apparent as those who usually do quite well in all conditions found the challenging winds of Lake Norman just that....a challenge to be met.

Congratulations to Howard and Stacy Roeschlein for their performance even though their finishes were recorded at both extremes of the fleet. Top 5 place scores were impressively close since others had found exactly the same scenario going from top end to bottom of finishes. This is what makes our class and our sport so inspiring.

Thanks to all for expressing concerns and care regarding the rather unfortunate exit that I made at the end of the Friday festivities. Biggest regret was that I did not get a chance to bid all a farewell that evening. All is good, Thank you Shelby and Nile for listening to my life story Friday evening/Saturday morning waiting to be evicted from the ER.
