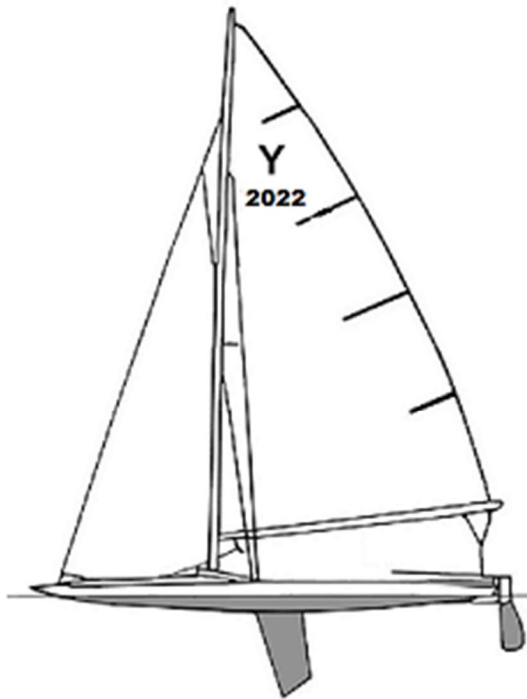

I get my first social security check October 26!

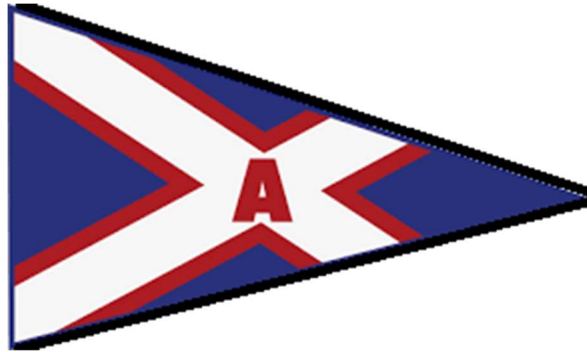
